





Want an extra challenge? See if you can spot these historic places while exploring Bakewell!

- Bakewell Bridge This famous stone bridge is really old it was built more than **700** *years ago* in the 1300s!
- Ducks on the Wye River Once you've found the bridge, it's hard to miss the river flowing beneath it! The River Wye is one of the longest rivers in the UK and is home to LOTS of ducks. You can even feed them with food found in many shops around town, including some on this map!
- All Saints Church This pretty church is even older than the bridge! It has two crosses from the **800s**, and you can spot its tall spire from all around Bakewell!
